We are writing in response to your request for support to repeal the legal requirements to wear seat belts within municipal limits.

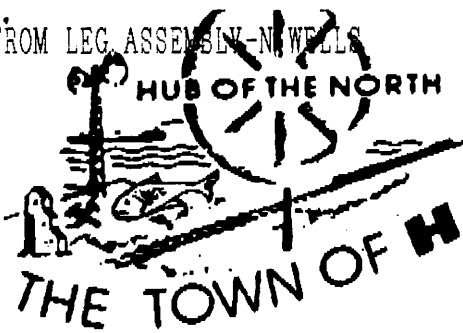

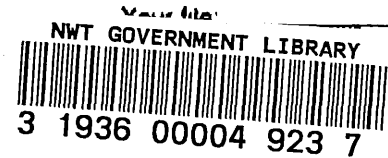

Our Hamlet will also encourage our Member, Ludy Pudluk, to support you effort.

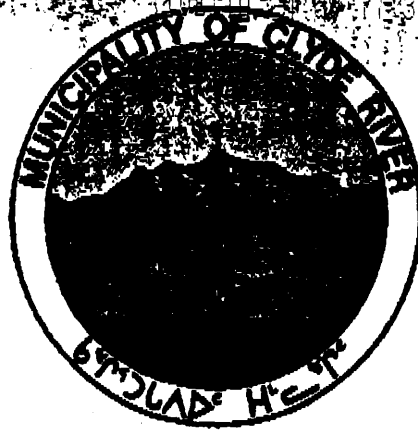

I am pleased to inform you that the Council of the Municipality of the Hamlet of Aklavik have passed a resolution supporting your efforts to have this legislation changed to allow for non-compliance within municipal boundaries. The N.W.T.A.M. have also researched this matter and Council supported them in their endeavors to stop the legislation prior to it being passed. However, they were not successful in their attempts.

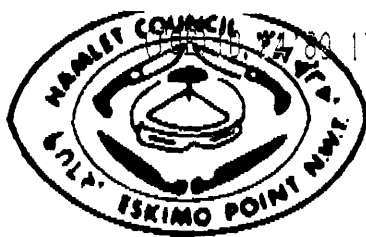
Council does support the mandatory use of seat belts on all N.W.T. highways but they support you in your attempts to have this legislation quashed for within municipal boundaries.

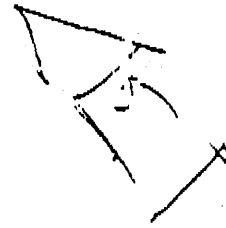

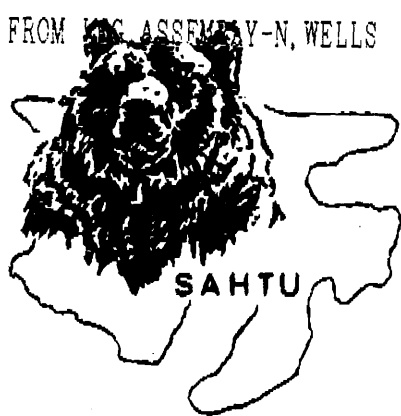

Legislative within Municipalities.

We fully support your endeavor to repeal the legal requirement to wear seat belts while inside municipal limits and while traveling on certain classes of roads in the N.W.T..

The Sahtu constituency consists of five communities of which our community is part of. Four of the five communities, Fort Franklin, Fort Norman, Norman Wells, and Fort Good Hope are accessible by winter roads only 2 or 3 months of the year. The limited accessibility to highways in addition to the speed restrictions of a maximum of 30 km per hour in most of these communities through municipal By-Laws would rather seem that the new seat belt legislation is unwarranted. Especially in isolated communities in our region.

Some of the immediate concerns that come to mind are:

- a) Transporting people to and from airports (airstrips) in communities that do not have taxi services and have limited vehicles with seat belt capacity of more than 2 persons.
- b) Transportation of elderly people and
- c) Large family inconvenience.

The council are in unanimous agreement that seat belt legislation should only be applicable to highways defined as such, Under The Public Highways Act.

The Municipal Councils should have the powers to pass by-laws regulating the use of seat belts within municipal limits. We strongly feel that this legislation can be handled by municipal council without effecting government safety standards.

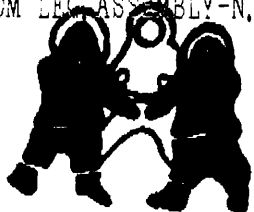
In Cape Dorset , it does not make sense to us to have a mandatory seat belt law as our community is small with a few short roads. There aren't any long stretches.
