

Funding was available due to delays in staffing positions, the use of casuals rather than contractors for marine refits and reduced contract expenditures in the Arctic Airports activity.
Municipal & Community Affairs	Directorate Community Works & Capital Planning Community Planning Mapping & Surveys Sports & Recreation	10,000 (12,000) (352,000) (16,000) 370,000	To provide additional funding to various capital projects affected by cost increases.  Funding was available to transfer from community planning due to lower tenders and scope changes for various projects.
Education	Directorate & Administration Advanced Education	350,000 (350,000)	To provide funding for higher than anticipated salary costs in the Directorate and Administration activity.  Funding was available from vacancies in apprenticeship and adult educator positions in the Advanced Education activity.
