RESOLUTION #12 - 90

Royal Canadian Mounted Police

WHEREAS the Royal Canadian Mounted Police have recently begun to actively recruit aboriginal people;

WHEREAS drug and alcohol abuse did not exist in traditional Inuit culture;

WHEREAS Keewatin Inuit are aware of growing drug and alcohol related problems in our communities; and

WHEREAS KIA believes that prevention programs are a much more effective way of fighting this problem than simply arresting people who break the law;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the 1990 Annual General Meeting of the Keewatin Inuit Association supports the effort being made by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to encourage young aboriginal people to join the force; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the KIA also supports the emphasis being placed by the RCMP on preventative drug and alcohol awareness and prevention programs.
