Transient Centres



WHEREAS Transient Centres were created to care for Inuit of the Keewatin region;

WHEREAS out-patients from Keewatin are mostly Inuit, who have their own language, culture and values; and

WHEREAS the high turnover of Inuit staff is due in part to a less than supportive work environment, which is a particularly difficult for people who also have to adjust to living in a different culture (the South);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the 1990 Annual General Meeting of the Keewatin Inuit Association urges the Keewatin Regional Health Board to make every effort to turn the Transient Centres in Churchill and Winnipeg into supportive workplaces which stimulate their Inuit staff and encourage them to develop a commitment to health care professions.
