Prime Minister Brian Mulroney today announced changes to the Ministry, including the appointment of one new Minister and the return to Cabinet of another, new portfolio assignments, and the designation of senior political Ministers for certain provinces.

## New Appointments to the Ministry

- 1) The Honourable Bernard Valcourt has been appointed Minister of Fisheries and Oceans. Mr. Valcourt will serve as a member of the Cabinet Committee on Priorities and Planning.
- 2) The Honourable Marcel Danis, M.P. for Verchères, has been sworn to the Privy Council and appointed Minister of State (Youth) and Minister of State (Fitness and Amateur Sport). Mr. Danis also will serve as Deputy Leader of the Government in the House of Commons.

## Government House Leader

- 3) In recognition of the importance which the Government attaches to carrying out a substantial legislative program, including the Goods and Services Tax, within the remainder of its current mandate, the Honourable Harvie Andre will devote his energies to his new responsibilities as Government House Leader, and to this end he has been appointed Minister of State to assist the Prime Minister, within the Prime Minister's portfolio.

Mr. Andre will serve as a member of the Cabinet Committee on Priorities and Planning and Chairman of the Cabinet Committee on Legislation and House Planning. Mr. Andre retains his responsibility for Canada Post Corporation.

New Assignments

- 4) The Honourable Tom Siddon has been appointed Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development and will continue to serve as a member of the Cabinet Committee on Priorities and Planning.
- 5) The Honourable Benoit Bouchard has been appointed Minister of Industry, Science and Technology, pursuant to the new Department of Industry, Science and Technology Act which was proclaimed today. Mr. Bouchard will continue to serve as a member of the Cabinet Committee on Priorities and Planning.
- 6) The Honourable Doug Lewis has been appointed Minister of Transport and will continue to serve as a member of the Cabinet Committee on Priorities and Planning.
- 7) The Honourable Frank Oberle has been sworn in as Minister of Forestry, pursuant to the new Department of Forestry Act which was proclaimed today.
- 8) The Honourable Pierre Cadieux has been appointed Solicitor General of Canada.
- 9) The Honourable Pierre Blais has been appointed Minister of Consumer and Corporate Affairs. Mr. Blais also will retain his current responsibilities as Minister of State (Agriculture).
- 10) The Honourable Shirley Martin has been appointed Minister of State (Indian Affairs and Northern Development).
- 11) The Honourable Mary Collins, Associate Minister of National Defence, has also been designated Minister responsible for the Status of Women.
- 12) The Honourable Kim Campbell has been appointed Minister of

- 13) The Honourable Jean Corbeil has been appointed Minister of State (Transport), in addition to his continuing responsibilities as Minister of Labour.
- 14) The Honourable William Winegard has been sworn in as Minister for Science within the Industry, Science and Technology Portfolio.
- 15) The Honourable Tom Hockin has been re-designated as Minister of State (Small Businesses and Tourism) to assist Mr. Benoit Bouchard in his new capacity as Minister of Industry, Science and Technology.

#### Other Assignments of Responsibility

The Minister of the Environment, the Honourable Lucien Bouchard, has been designated as Minister with senior political responsibility within the Cabinet for matters relating to Quebec. The Honourable Marcel Masse, who had performed this task, had asked the Prime Minister to relieve him of the responsibility. The Prime Minister thanked Mr. Masse for his "loyal and effective service in this post".

The Honourable Kim Campbell will carry senior political responsibility in relation to British Columbia.

The Honourable Bernard Valcourt will share senior political responsibility for New Brunswick with the Honourable Gerald Merrithew.

In the province of Ontario, the Honourable Michael Wilson retains senior political responsibility. He will henceforth be assisted in that task by the Honourable Doug Lewis and the Honourable Paul Dick.
