\$. A vehicle that cost \$20,000. five years ago now costs \$35,000. Because all of the above depend on my services and a good part of my load is fresh produce and frozen food I now require a vehicle with a diesel engine and 4 wheel drive, as anyone who has driven the Arctic Bay road in foul weather would understand.

I have not increased my rates for five years and as Canada Post have removed part of the subsidy on food mail shipments, I do not wish to do so now.
