The portion of Yellowknife Highway that encompasses the Bison Sanctuary is unfortunately riddled with a lot of curves. Our suggestion is to straighten out the Highway right - of- way by brushing out the curves from km 25 to km 95. This should aid on -coming traffic to sight any the obstacles or animals before it's too late.

Obviously, the band would quite anxious to participate in a project such as this. Particularly with the slump in the Fur Industry and we have a lot of Experienced Slasher from the Hire North Days. we await your reply and initiative.
