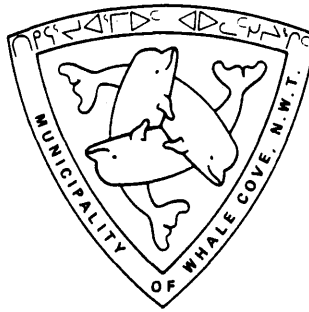

Dear Peter;

At our last regular Council meeting held Dec.1,1988 Your letter was brought to the attention of the Council.

The Council supports your letter by the following recommendations as follows.

1. To see the use of the aboriginal languages made on flights as well as in the terminals by all air lines involved.
2. The Adoption of the safety procedure cards, brochures, and all correspondence in Inuktitut and English.
3. Employment of Inuit in Terminal staff positions as well as flight attendants staff positions are the sort of measures required to address the current state of inadequacy.
4. The quality of flights service presently being provided is worse than before where we presently only get two flights a week and before we use to get three or four flights a week with no Inuktitut on all flights.

These are our concerns about Air services and flight operation which we are not happy about at Whale Cove N.W.T.
