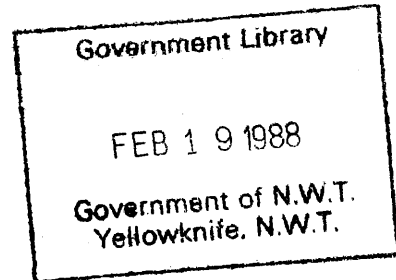

- Whereas, The school structural frame has been declared unsound by the Fire Marshall, and Safety Inspectors;
- And whereas, The majority of the structural frame are decayed rottened;
- And whereas, The water pipes are worn out causing leakage;
- And whereas, There is constant noise throughout the classrooms from the old hot water heating systems' pipe, distracting teachers and students;
- And whereas, The building consumes over 500 gallons of fuel for ten days because of severe heat loss;
- And whereas, Minor repairs are constantly required;
- And whereas, The cleaning of the water tank is awkward due to limited space;
- And whereas, In order to clean the water tank, classes will have to be disrupted, and the water tank and pipes have to be dismantled;
- And whereas, The water tank is too close to the furnace causing high bacteria built up;
- And whereas, Major renovation is uneconomical;
- And whereas, Grise Fiord was established for sovereignty purposes;
- And whereas, People who grew up in Grise Fiord consider Grise Fiord as permanent home;
- And whereas, Most families want to remain in Grise Fiord;
- And whereas, No factual committment dates from the people to move to other communities have been indicated;
- And whereas, All grades up to grade eight are taught in only two (2) classrooms causing high probability of lack of learning;
- And whereas, The majority of children, students growing up time is spent in classroom environment, where our present class does not adequately facilitate.

And whereas, The Hamlet of Grise Fiord has learnt through the media that the Gov't has either postpones or cancelled the new school project;

And whereas, This postponement or cancellation is based on rumors created by the G.N.W.T. that most residents were relocating to their place of origin;

And now therefore, be it resolved that the proposed new school project be continued for the fiscal year 1988/89 as originally planned;
