BE IT RESOLVED that this conference supports the establishment of the Keewatin Youth Council / Kivallirmiut Makkuktungita Katimajingit.

GOALS:

To voice the opinions and concerns of the young people of the Keewatin Region (ages 16 and up) on issues that directly or indirectly affect them;

To support youth councils in the communities by sharing information, experience and resources, and by organizing workshops and meetings;

Provide leadership and lifeskills experience and training to its members;

Keep members informed on issues that are of interest and concern to its members.

STRUCTURE:

Twelve members, elected as follows:

- -one member representing each of the seven communities in the region; chosen initially from the delegates to the founding convention but in following years elected by the youth of the communities;
- -one member representing the students of the Keewatin Education Centre, chosen initially from the delegates to the founding convention but in following years elected by the students of KEC;
- one member representing the residents of Kivalliq Hall, chosen initially from the delegates to the founding convention but in following years elected by the residents of Kivalliq Hall;
