

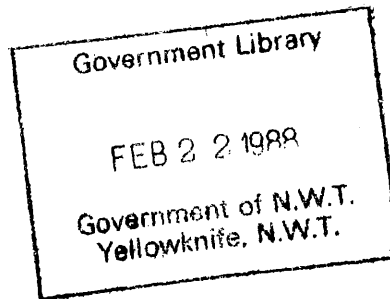

Re: Visits to communities from Legislative Assembly
Committees

The Hamlet Council of Resolute Bay in a meeting held February 1, 1988 recommended that various committees formed by the Legislative Assembly visit the communities instead of requesting that members of the communities go to Yellowknife to speak with the committees.

We understand that a representative from the Hamlet of Resolute Bay may be requested to speak with the Economic Committee in Yellowknife in the near future. We would prefer that this Committee, as well as other Committees formed by the Legislative Assembly consider community visits instead. Using the Economic Committee as an example, we feel that a community visit would be beneficial for the following reason:

1. All members of the community would have a chance to speak to the Committee.
2. The Committee would receive more ideas for job creations from local people.
3. The Committee would view first hand of the resources presently available in communities.
4. The Committee would be able to talk to employers that wouldn't otherwise be able to talk to the Committee.

We hope you will consider our recommendation.
