Whereas, these Terms of Reference are deficient as they do not make provision for independent staff for the ADCC, and;

Whereas, new information has been obtained that Mr. Mongeau will be invited to attend the next meeting of an interim Management Team, which will act in the place of the ADCC and the Board of Management until a decision has been made as to the future of the ADCC or the Board of Management;

Therefore, I move that the BRC withhold nomination for the ADCC representative such time as full consultation takes place and BRADIC/ TUVVIK is given an opportunity for input into the ADCC Terms of Reference, and I further move that if Mr. Mongeau is invited to attend an Interim group that he be allowed to attend to voice the concerns of the Eastern Arctic Alcohol Programs and the BRC, and point out that all of the above decisions have been made without any consultation with the BRC or with the Alcohol Programs of the Eastern Arctic.

Whereas, the Federal Government through Health and Welfare Canada (NNADAP) has agreed to provide 1.6 million dollars for the construction of the Tuvvik Treatment Centre, and;

Whereas, the best architectural estimates of the construction of this building are 2.2 million dollars, and;

Whereas, the ADCC asked the Minister of Health and Social Services to consider allocating the additional funds necessary to constructing this building, and;

Whereas, the ADCC also asked the Minister of Health and Social Services to cost/share the additional operating costs of this Treatment Centre, and;

Whereas, the Minister of Health and Social Services was unable to commit these funds because of other priorities, and;

Whereas, the funding for this project is important and decisions must be made on the additional funding as soon as possible (ie. by the end of November of 1987) because of sealift for next summer;

Therefore, I move that the BRC write to the Minister of Health and Social Services, indicating that this project is very important to the people of the Eastern Arctic, and request that the Minister reconsider the priorities set in the last session of the Legislative Assembly with the view of funding this project both with the necessary additional capital dollars (approx. \$800,000) to build the Centre and the additional operating and maintenance funds (approx. \$350,000 per year) that will be necessary for it's operation I further move that the BRC ask the MLA's of the Baffin Region to support the above motion and urge the Minister of Health and Social Services to seriously consider the above motion as soon as possible.
