RE: REQUEST NOT TO DELIVER SPECIAL TRAPPING LICENCES

At the last South Slave Regional Council meeting held in Fort Smith on January 6th-8th, 1988 this motion was carried unanimously.

South Slave Regional Council Motion #141 reads;

"Whereas, the Hunters & Trappers Association of the Town of Hay River has had continued pressure from Wildlife Conservation Groups as to handing out special trapping licences;

whereas, the Hunters & Trappers Association has let it be known that this decision is based upon the limited space available to Aboriginal People who also are trapping.

Therefore, be it resolved that the South Slave Regional Council support the Hunters & Trappers Association in Hay River as to their continued efforts not to deliver Special Trapping Licences to non-Dene/Metis people of the South Slave Region."
