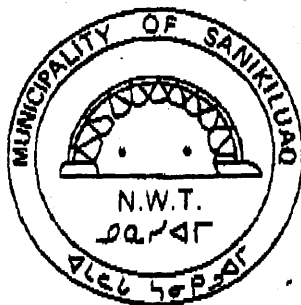


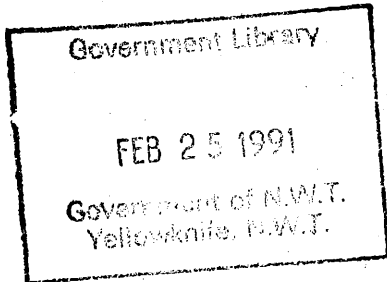

RE: Request of Contribution:  
Economic Coordinating Position and other Expenses

x As the only community, situated most isolated from the rest of the Baffin Region, we are deeply concerned about our Economic Development future.

When we state our community has been hit most hard by recent recession in order to proceed to our target of economic development, the first major problem already exists. Without a full-time economic coordinator position, we will not be able to function proceed in addressing our concerning.

x In the last few years there are a number of things we have looked into as economic potentials:

- sea food surveying through Co-op
- main soapstone quarry cleanup
- eider down cleaning
- eider down manufactory, still in progress
- community sewing store
- tourism development,

Other things that we would like to look into such as:

- tourism development

- community shipping venture (Serving Hudson Bay Communities)
- small wood cutting industry
- more seafood surveying
- duffle products manufacturing

These are only a few things, and each one of them will take time to process.

At present, our only economic development officer is situated a few hundred miles away, and we only see her or him once or twice a year. And, we all know when someone is out of town 99% of the time, there is no way they will know what to know, what to expect for what is really needed in the community.

All the economic projects that we have dealt with the last five year's have only been able to proceed with our 1 year term economic planner and eider down coordinating contracts.

The eider down coordingation contract now expires this coming end of March 1991. The project will be slightly in complete, but in a short time we are hoping to form eider down co-operative, and let it run independent of municipal operations.

If this can proceed within 2 months it will be big step for the community economy. But, it is no where near to replacing the carving income we are losing now.

Therefore we are deeply concerned we should have full time economic planner position in the community.

We have been doing this on contract basis, and we learn from this. But first and second year's are only starting time. If your are willing to support us, we would recommend your contribution be put into our yearly contribution fund. Then, we will hire full-time economic coordinator.

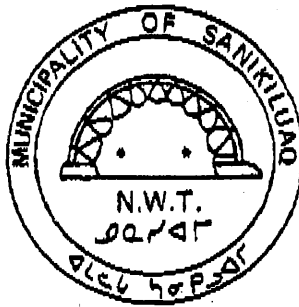
We are forwarding attached calculation of expenses for you to review. We would like to see it happen at the beginning of the fiscal year 1991/92.
