## 1991-92 Licence Fee Changes

As part of the 1991-92 Oplan, the department proposed a revised schedule of licence and permit fees. This proposal was accepted by the Financial Management Board and although we requested an implementation date of July 1, 1992, we were directed to put the new fee structure into place July 1, 1991.

The attached schedule lists the new prices and shows for comparative purposes the existing rates. These rates are being incorporated into regulation changes which will be in force by the start of the new licence year.

Please inform all vendors and operators who account to you of the impending changes by way of the attached letter.

The financial Management Board has also confirmed that we must charge GST on licences. I have checked with Revenue Canada regarding all the licences and permits we issue and they have advised that the only licences requiring the GST are hunting and fishing licences, tags, and trophy fees. Non-resident aliens must pay the tax, but they may be eligible to obtain refunds from the Federal Government.
