

We are discussing our school program for next year and it has come to our attention that there should be a review of the grade 10 inuktitut 15 course. We are also looking at extending our school program to grade 11 in the near future and we are concerned that there is no inuktitut curriculum for grades 11 and 12.

It seems that for a long time we have been promised an inuktitut curriculum for the entire school program from kindergarten to grade 12. This is a serious issue for us because we want our children to receive a good education in inuktitut. The learning of inuktitut will not be taken seriously if there is not even a curriculum for teachers to follow.

We would appreciate your support in drawing attention to this most important concern of ours.
