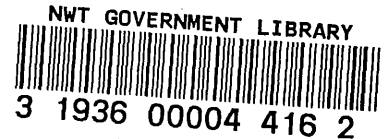

In the letter of August 10, 1989 from Dennis Cichelly, which is also taken as a signed "Contract", Canada Post provided a five day course on products and procedures for the Postmaster and the Sr. Administration Officer.

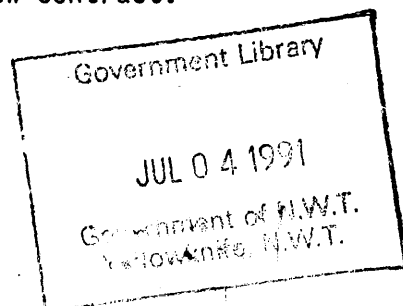
It is also stated "With close co-operation between the Northern Services Division of Canada Post and the Hamlet administration, we will together provide a quality postal service in Coral Harbour."

Also in terms of termination, the contract, by the way it reads only allows Canada Post to terminate it.

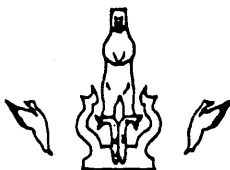
This contract is almost 2 years old. We have a new administrator and also a new Post Master. Also GST Has come into effect as of January 1, 1991. I know the S.A.O. does not understand much about Postal Operations and has been trying to work with the new Post Master to keep the Post Office going. I also know that Canada Post sent in booklets to read in regards to new procedures due to GST. To someone who doesn't know your operation it's kind of hard to read the books. Also, with our Post Master who's first language is Inuktitut, it is hard to understand the instructions in the booklets. I wonder if southern Post Offices had these booklets or someone to go into the community to train them.

I think, since the Post Office was forced on to Council to run it, or Coral Harbour would have to deal with the post office in Rankin Inlet that Canada Post should supply on-going training to our Post Masters.

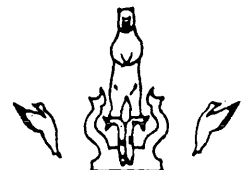
I also believe that someone from your department should come to Coral Harbour to re-negotiate a new contract.


