REPORT ON NEGOTIATED CONTRACTS AWARDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

IN 1992/93 & 1993/94



Introduction

This report provides a list and brief analysis of Department of Transportation contracts which were approved for negotiation by the Executive Council during the last two fiscal years.


The objective of these awards was the maximization of local employment and business opportunities associated with the activities of the Department. Although the usual procedure for award of government contracts is through a competitive tender or request for proposal (RfP) process, there are situations where meeting the local business development objectives of the government are better achieved through a negotiated contract process.

The GNWT seeks to maximize local involvement and to provide opportunities for the creation and development of companies or organizations involved with various public works.

The following five principles are applied to the development and delivery of negotiated contracts for transportation infrastructure construction and maintenance:

- 1. Local and northern residents should receive every opportunity to benefit from public dollars spent in the North;
- 2. Business creation and development should provide an investment opportunity for local and northern residents;
- 3. Opportunities should be provided to create employment, training and management experience for local and northern residents;

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- 4. Construction, operation and maintenance of transportation infrastructure should be provided at a reasonable price; and
- Negotiated contract opportunities should contribute to the goal of creating and maintaining self-sustaining business enterprises, capable of competing on the open market.

Assessment

A total of 17 negotiated contracts were awarded between 1 April 1992 and 30 November 1993, as indicated on the attached Schedules for 1992/93 and 1993.

The schedule indicates the organizations awarded the negotiated contract, as well as the nature of the work undertaken, the estimated tender price, the negotiated contract cost, and the estimated premium, if any, paid by the Department in respect to the contract.

Only one of the contracts was not successfully completed, due in part to a lack of adequate management by the contractor. In all other cases the work covered by the contract was satisfactorily completed.

The objectives of the negotiated contract award have been achieved in all cases. All negotiated contracts were awarded to northern contractors, and a higher percentage of local involvement has been achieved, than would have been the case if the work was opened to public tender process.

The number and value of negotiated contracts represents only a small proportion of the total number and value of all contracts let during this reporting period. Between 1 April 1992 and 30 November 1993, 905 contracts with a total value of in excess of \$84 million were let by the Department. The negotiated contracts thus represent approximately 2% in number, and 7.5% in value, of all contracts issued by the Department in this period.
