The *Nunavut Act*, s. 76.05, requires the Government of the Northwest Territories to consult with Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated, "NTI", before the Interim Commissioner recommends to the Commissioner in Council legislative measures relating to the governance of Nunavut. We have been advised by the Office of the Interim Commissioner that the *Nunavut Statutes Amendment Act*, 1999, the "Act," will be recommended by the Interim Commissioner to the Commissioner in Council.

On behalf of NTI, I am pleased to provide the Honourable Minister with this letter confirming that the Government of the Northwest Territories has consulted with NTI regarding the Act. The consultation process has been satisfactory in all respects. We concur with the recommendation of the Interim Commissioner that the enactment of this legislation will make possible the necessary amendment of certain statutes that will be duplicated for Nunavut by section 29 of the *Nunavut Act*.


