(*) The April 1, 2003 indemnity payable to chairpersons of standing committees of the Legislative Assembly had been \$3,386. However, the independent commission that reviewed Members' Compensation and Benefits in 2002 recommended that at the commencement of the 15th Legislative Assembly of the Northwest Territories this indemnity be increased to \$5,000.

(**) Prior to the 15th Legislative Assembly of the Northwest Territories a chairperson of a Special Committee created by the Assembly was not paid an indemnity for chairing the committee. However, the independent commission that reviewed Members' Compensation and Benefits in 2002 recommended that effective with the 15th Legislative Assembly of the Northwest Territories the chairperson of a special committee shall be entitled to an annual indemnity of \$2,500
