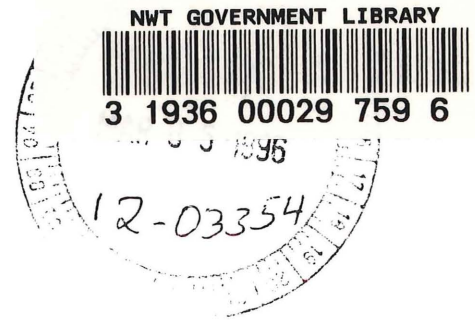

Hunters' & Trappers' Organization Committee members would like to request five more muskox tags for Boothia Peninsula. For the benefit of our people.

We were notified of the increase in both caribou and muskoxen on the Boothia Peninsula, which will affect hunters in Taloyoak. The survey which was done in July 1995, also showed an increase in muskoxen on Prince of Wales Island and Somerset Island, and to protect the Boothia caribou population we would like to have five more muskox tags for Boothia Peninsula.
