Re: Proposed Merger of OHS with the WCB

Dear Mr. Aho,

It has come to our attention that the Government of Northwest Territories may merge Occupational Health and Safety with the WCB. This would be a significant step which would have substantial impact on WCB premiums as well as on safety enforcement and inspection.

This type of proposal would require thorough evaluation and we have questions regarding its possible consequences. On behalf of our 240 members in the Northwest Territories, we urge the government to delay any merger (if our information is factual) and to commence a broad consultative process on the concept of amalgamation. The consultation should include modelling on the possible impact on rates, the likely impact on WCB/OH&S operations, and the effects on safety inspection and enforcement systems.


