Housing

At the recent NWTTA Central Executive meeting held on December 6, 1997, the Regional Presidents' Representative reported on regional concerns.

A crucial concern across the Northwest Territories for teachers is that of housing. The cost of housing, the poor quality of available rental units and the high cost of utilities is making it next to impossible for our members to continue teaching in the NWT.

Our members are telling us that they are finding it extremely difficult to live in our smaller communities. The quality of education will suffer if we continue to lose experienced northern teachers. This is a grave concern for the NWTTA.

The NWTTA urges the Divisional Education Councils and the District Education authorities to take a proactive role in this area. It may become necessary for DEC's and DEA's to become actively involved in supplying affordable, adequate housing to teachers.
