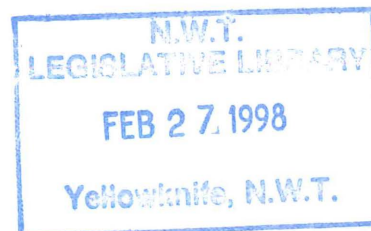
**Riding Concern**


A letter of encouragement and support for your recent publicity
