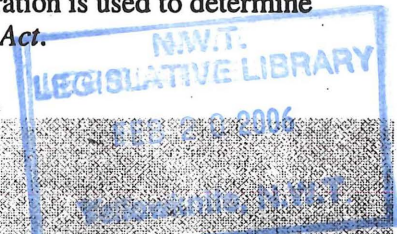




STATUTORY DECLARATION OF RESIDENCE

Each Member of the Legislative Assembly must complete a statutory declaration of residence required under section 14 of the *Indemnities, Allowances and Expense Regulations*. The declaration is used to determine payments to the Member under the *Legislative Assembly and Executive Council Act*.



DECLARATION:

I, Kevin A Menicoche, a Member of the Legislative Assembly of the Northwest Territories, **DO SOLEMNLY DECLARE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The address at which I normally reside when I am not required to be in Yellowknife to fulfill my Member's responsibilities is:

- Copy of telephone bill for my residence; and
- Copy of my power bill for my residence. ✓
