I am a resident of the Northwest Territories which has one of the highest rates of addictions in Canada. The Government of the Northwest Territories has identified that addictions treatment is a priority of this government in creating and maintaining healthy communities.

It is of the utmost importance to the residents of the Northwest Territories that they receive quality care that is close to home, culturally relevant and appropriate, and addresses the unique needs of Northerners.

It is imperative that the dignity and respect of northern clients and their caregivers be restored by the immediate resolution of this lockout.

Therefore, by my signature below, I hereby demand that all steps necessary be taken by all levels of Government to encourage the Board of Nats\'ejee K\'eh Treatment Centre to immediately resolve this lockout; meet with the union to negotiate a fair collective agreement for the locked out workers; and re-open the Nats\'ejee K\'eh Treatment Centre.
